John 14:15-27

Gospellor The Lord be with you.

Gospellor The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ is written in the 14th chapter of the Gospel according to John, beginning at verse 15.

All Glory to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.

"I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. Yet a little while and the world will see me no more, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live. In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you. Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him." Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, "Lord, how is it that you will manifest yourself to us, and not to the world?"

Jesus answered him, "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. Whoever does not love me does not keep my words. And the word that you hear is not mine but the Father's who sent me.

"These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you. But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you

all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.” (ESV) This is the Gospel of the Lord

And so, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, we your humble servants, with all your holy church, remembering the precious death of your beloved Son, his mighty resurrection, his glorious ascension, and looking for his coming again in glory, make before you, in this Sacrament of the holy Bread of eternal life and the Cup of everlasting salvation, the memorial which he has commanded; and we wholly desire your fatherly goodness mercifully to accept this our sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving, as we humbly ask you, by the merits and death of your Son Jesus Christ, and through faith in his Blood, to grant to us and all your church the remission of our sins, and all other benefits of his passion.
