The 1st Reading: *Jeremiah 18:1-17*

The first reading is from the eighteenth chapter of the book of Jeremiah, beginning at first verse.

This is the word that came to Jeremiah from the Lord: ² "Go down to the potter's house, and there I will give you my message." ³ So I went down to the potter's house, and I saw him working at the wheel. ⁴ But the pot he was shaping from the clay was marred in his hands; so the potter formed it into another pot, shaping it as seemed best to him. ⁵ Then the word of the Lord came to me. ⁶ He said, "Can I not do with you, Israel, as this potter does?" declares

the Lord. "Like clay in the hand of the potter, so are you in my hand, Israel. ⁷ If at any time I announce that a nation or kingdom is to be uprooted, torn down and destroyed, ⁸ and if that nation I warned repents of its evil, then I will relent and not inflict on it the disaster I had planned. ⁹ And if at another time I announce that a nation or kingdom is to be built up and planted, ¹⁰ and if it does evil in my sight and does not obey me, then I will reconsider the good I had intended to do for it. ¹¹ "Now therefore say to the people of Judah and those living in Jerusalem, 'This is what the Lord says: Look! I am preparing a disaster for you and devising a plan against you. So turn from your evil ways, each one of you, and reform your ways and your actions.' ¹² But they will reply, 'It's no use. We will continue with our own plans; we will all follow the stubbornness of our evil hearts.'" ¹³ Therefore this is what the Lord says: "Inquire among the nations: Who has ever heard anything like this? A most horrible thing has been done by Virgin Israel. ¹⁴ Does the snow of Lebanon ever vanish from its rocky slopes? Do its cool waters from distant sources ever stop flowing? ¹⁵ Yet my people have forgotten me; they burn incense to worthless idols, which made them stumble in their ways, in the ancient paths. They made them walk in byways, on roads not built up. ¹⁶ Their land will be an object of horror and of lasting scorn; all who pass by will be appalled and will shake their heads. ¹⁷ Like a wind from the east, I will scatter them before their enemies; I will show them my back and not my face in the day of their disaster."

The 2nd Reading: Luke 4:1-15

The second reading is from the fourth chapter of the Gospel of Luke, beginning at the first verse.

Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, left the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, ² where for forty days he was tempted by the devil. He ate nothing during those days, and at the end of them

he was hungry. ³ The devil said to him, "If you are the Son of God, tell this stone to become bread."

⁴ Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone.'" ⁵ The devil led him up to a high place and showed him in an instant all the kingdoms of the world. ⁶ And he said to him, "I will give you all their authority and splendor; it has been given to me, and I can give it to anyone I want to. ⁷ If you worship me, it will all be yours."

⁸ Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Worship the Lord your God and serve him only.'" ⁹ The devil led him to Jerusalem and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down from here. ¹⁰ For it is written: "'He will command his angels concerning you to guard you carefully; ¹¹ they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.'" ¹² Jesus answered, "It is said: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'" ¹³ When the devil had finished all this tempting, he left him until an opportune time. ¹⁴ Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about him spread through the whole countryside. ¹⁵ He was teaching in their synagogues, and everyone praised him.

PLEASE READ: NOTICES ABOUT RESUMING SERVICES AT ST. DAVID'S CHURCH BEGINNING JUNE 14.

It's wonderful to be back together for worship this Sunday!

As of June 8, we have entered Phase 3 of Re-Open Saskatchewan, with new provincial [Guidelines for Accommodating Worship](#), as well as updated [new directives](#) from our Bishops.

St. David's has resumed worship on June 14, with one service only, beginning at 9:30 a.m. (summer hours), and limited to 30 congregants only. We cannot go over this number. Our bishops have set the following directives (summarized; to read the letter, [click here](#)), and which may be updated as re-opening continues. Any updates will be posted to our "[News](#)" feed, and may effect changes. For a complete list of Directives, read the [letter](#) from the diocese available on our website.

Things of note:

As we resume services things are going to be quite a bit different. We hope in time we will see further easing of restrictions and increased numbers. ***As directives and guidelines change, we will change with them.***

First, there will only be one service, as is usual in the summer, on Sundays at 9:30 a.m. (June-August), and limited to at this time to 30 congregants. Worship will follow the provincial and diocesan guidelines set by both as of the week of June 8. ***Those who are ill with a communicable disease and those who are particularly vulnerable must stay home.***

Second, when you enter the Narthex, someone will greet you, and make a booklet available for you. If you take it home, we encourage you to not share it with other family members. The booklet is available on our website, [stdavidspa.org](#).

Third, no offering will be taken up during the service. If you have an offering, please place it in the plate available outside of the sanctuary. As well, you can still use our [electronic offering options](#), which we encourage.

Fourth, we ask you to enter the sanctuary **maintaining 6 feet / 2 meters distance** between you or your household, and others. Please proceed up the aisle. Pews will be marked, and each "mark" represents "a household" or individual. To respect social distancing, **please beginning seating in the front pews first.**


Fifth, there will be no congregational singing at this time.

Sixth, during the administration of communion, **please remain in your seat.** After several meetings, the wardens and rector decided the best way to maintain social distance would be to remain in your seat, rather than lining up, as some in pews would be forced to breach the two-meter distance. **The priest will bring the bread to you, and must wear a mask during distribution.**

Finally, when the service is over, we ask that congregants depart **back pews first** to exit the church, and retaining the 6 feet / 2 meters of social distance with others. **The minister cannot greet you at the door, and we are not allowed to linger for fellowship in our building.**

1. When you enter the sanctuary, please sit where marked, as an individual, couple, or "household" - This will keep us 2 meters apart.
2. Please sit filling seats in order, from front to back.
3. During communion, please remain seated for distribution. The bread will be delivered to you.
4. When you leave the sanctuary, please allow people to leave from the back of the sanctuary first.

- Place offering in plate **before** entering the sanctuary.
- Pick up a service booklet **before** entering the sanctuary.
- As you enter, please maintain 6 ft. /2 meters distance.


